## How to report a FIRE:

- If a burning odor or smoke is present, pull the fire alarm, then call 911 and Public Safety 740-366-9237. Report the exact location of the fire and, if known, what is burning.
- 2. If you can help control the fire without personal danger, take action with available fire fighting equipment. If not, leave the area.
- 3. Never allow the fire to come between you and the exit.
- Remove all people from the danger area. Close doors behind you to confine the fire.

## 5. Response to audible Fire Alarms:

- If the audible horn alarm sounds for more than 15 seconds, evacuate the building.
- 7. Do not use elevators.
- 8. If requested, accompany and assist people with disabilities who appear to need direction or assistance.
- 9. Leave all parcels and personal property inside.
- 10. Remain approximately 100 feet from the exits to help facilitate clear access to the building for the Fire Department.
- 11. Return to the building only when instructed to do so by campus officials or Fire Department personnel.
- 12. Planning includes training in the proper use of the fire extinguishers and knowing their locations.
